THE DISTRICT AND COMMUNITY

Conroe Independent School District covers an area of 348 square miles. More than 50,000 students attend six high schools, seven junior high schools, three special program sites, including two magnet school programs, and numerous elementary and intermediate campuses. Oak Ridge High School serves students in the southern portion of Montgomery County. We are located 27 miles north of downtown Houston and are in an important regional center for more than 1000 businesses.

ACADEMIC INFORMATION

ORHS is a comprehensive high school with an enrollment of over 3600 students. We offer a wide range of curricular and extra-curricular opportunities, allowing students as many choices as possible.

The school day consists of alternating four period days (odd/even) with each period approximately 90 minutes for a total of 8 periods. Students are expected to graduate on the Foundation High School Plan with Endorsement or Distinguished Level of Achievement, which requires 4 credits of English, 4 credits of Math (to include Algebra 2), 4 credits of Science (Biology, Chemistry, Physics or Principles of Technology, and 1 additional science), 4 credits of Social Studies, 2 credits of Foreign Language, 1 credit of Fine Arts, 1 credit of Physical Education, Health, and 5.5 elective credits on the student's chosen endorsement. Class rank is based on the weighted cumulative grade point average for grades 9-12. A student's grade point average is determined by dividing the total number of grade points by the number of semester courses attempted. All state accredited courses are considered in the calculation. Grade points are awarded according to course rigor.
