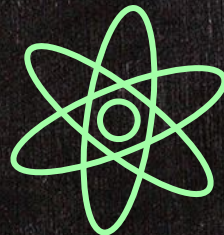




Student Expectations

2022-2023



Two Campuses/One School

- ★ Students should NOT be on either campus UNLESS they have a class ON that campus.
 - If students are on either campus during a time they should NOT be, they will be considered out of location and receive a consequence.
- ★ Our campuses are closed campuses. Once here, students may not leave without following proper check-out procedures.

Attendance Requirements for Credit

Regular school attendance is essential for students to make the most of their educational experience.

According to state law, students must be in attendance 90 percent of the time to receive credit.

It is an expectation that all classes will be so rigorous that students cannot pass without attending the class.

Attendance for Credit

90% Rule

Students must be in attendance 90% of the days a class is offered in order to receive credit for the course.

No more than 7 absences per class

If a student is absent 8 or more days per semester (excused and unexcused combined) they will lose credit for the class, regardless of the grade earned in the class.

Truancy

Excessive absences and/or skipping can and will lead to a truancy court filing.

Attendance Procedures

Need a Note

- ▶ from a parent/guardian
- ▶ required when students miss school for a partial day or a whole day
- ▶ must be taken to the attendance office before/after school or during the lunch period, within 48 hours after returning to school

Leaving Campus

Special Circumstances: Students who drive

- ▶ If leaving school early, a note including a parent signature is required
- ▶ The note is to be turned

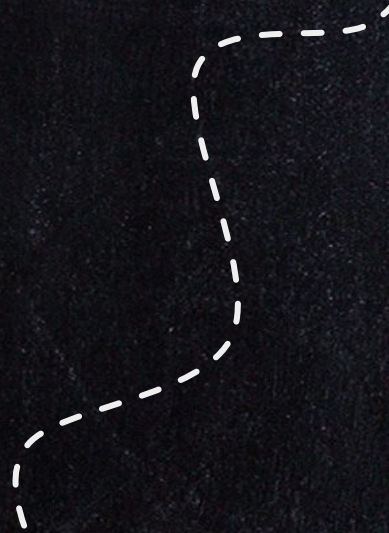
Signing Out Through Attendance

- ▶ Once the student leaving early has been vetted by the grade level office, students **MUST** sign out through attendance.
- ▶ **STUDENTS MUST SIGN OUT IN THE ATTENDANCE OFFICE!**

Teachers, please reinforce this with students!

Tardies

- ★ 7 minute passing periods
- ★ Students are considered tardy up to 15 minutes
- ★ Tardies are cumulative (not per class)
- ★ Tardies will start over each week
- ★ A referral is generated on the 3rd tardy
 - Consequences *could* include
 - Lunch Detention
 - After School Detention (ASD)
 - Saturday Detention



Electronic Devices

- ★ Bring to school at your own risk.
- ★ Only permitted
 - Before school
 - After school and
 - During non-instructional times such as the passing periods and lunch
 - One earbud only during passing periods.
- ★ Should NEVER be used as a camera/video to capture any inappropriate activity (i.e. to record a fight)
- ★ Teachers decide where phones are stored in the classroom AND when they can be used.

Dress Code

Guidelines for dress code include

- ★ Must **cover areas and undergarments**
 - Armpit to armpit, down to middle of thigh
 - Tops must have straps and cover the stomach such that the belly button cannot be seen.
 - No rips, tears or holes higher than the middle of the thigh
- ★ **Shoes at all times** - No slippers or bedroom shoes
- ★ **No see-through or mesh** garments without appropriate coverage underneath
- ★ **NO** headgear including **hats, hoodies, bandanas, head scarves, skull caps, do-rags, beanies, hair bonnets, and caps** are NOT allowed unless for religious, medical or admin approved reasons.
- ★ Specialized courses may require specialized attire
 - Sports = uniforms and/or safety gear

Dress Code Cont

Additional Requirements

★ Clothing **MAY NOT** depict, imply, advertise or advocate

- Illegal, violent or lewd conduct,
- Pornography, nudity, or sexual acts,
- Vulgar, discriminatory, or obscene language or images
- Hate speech/imagery targeting groups based on race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, religious affiliation or other protected classifications
- No sunglasses in the building
- Clothing and accessories that endanger students or staff MAY NOT be worn
- Apparel, jewelry, accessories, tattoos or grooming that, by virtue of its color, arrangement trademark or other attribute, denotes membership in a gang that advocates illegal or disruptive behavior IS PROHIBITED.

Dress Code - The Final Word

Ultimately...

- ★ The administration (Mr. Almond, Mrs. Burks and APs) of Oak Ridge High School determine what constitutes appropriate dress.
- ★ Students who do not adhere to these guidelines will NOT be allowed to attend class.
- ★ Parents will be notified when there is a dress code violation.

Easy Rule of Thumb

If you question it in the morning, you should NOT wear it.

Red (Odd) = Periods **1, 3, 5 & 7**

Blue (Even) = Periods **2, 4, 6 & 8**

- ★ **7 minute** passing periods
- ★ Eagles Nest is every day after **3rd** and **4th**
- ★ Lunch is determined by your **5th** or **6th** period class.

Cafeteria/Lunch

General Expectations

★ **Clean up after yourself**

- All trash should be picked up and thrown away before you leave your table.

★ **Behavior**

- Treat all workers and custodians with respect.

Unacceptable Behavior

Fighting

This includes confrontations and “peacocking”

Bullying and Harassment

NEVER Bully or Harass another student

Sexual Harassment/ Comments/Gestures

PDA

No smooching allowed. Remember to “Catch and Release”

Inappropriate Behavior on Buses

Everything on the bus is under video surveillance.

Academic Dishonesty

Cheating and Plagiarism

Cheating / Violating Test Procedures

What it includes:

- ★ Letting another student copy work or copying someone else's
- ★ Using materials during test when not allowed
- ★ Having your phone or other electronic device out during a test

Consequences:

- ★ Consequences will be determined after an investigation has been conducted by the student's AP.

Verbal Aggression, Fighting & Profanity

Verbal Aggression/Confrontations

- ★ Verbal confrontations which disrupt the school or learning environment are UNACCEPTABLE.
- ★ If you participate in a verbal confrontation, you will be subject to being sent home for the remainder of the day or an ISS placement.

Fighting will NOT be Tolerated

- ★ Send home for remainder of the day
- ★ Combination of OSS/ISS

FYI: Assault is a crime.

Profanity is Prohibited

- ★ Any profanity used = ASD, Saturday Detention or ISS depending on the situation.
- ★ Profanity directed at ANY staff member = OSS and/or ISS

Tobacco and E-Cigs/Vapes

Tobacco is NOT allowed on campus. It is a violation the CISD Student Code of Conduct.

Tobacco/Electronic Cigarette violations will be subject to 4 days of ISS every time.

Consequences for Illegal, Prescription, and Over-the-Counter Drugs

★ There **MAY**
be legal
consequences

★ There **WILL**
be school
consequences

Specific School Consequences

- ★ Possession, use, and/or delivery of liquid THC or other substances
 - **DAEP** – up to 15 days
 - **Mandatory Expulsion**
 - Possible expulsion up to one calendar year
- ★ Texas Education Code: Chapters 37.006 and 37.007
