## Cheerleader Responsibilities



Cheerleading requires a SIGNIFICANT amount of time, commitment and dedication on the part of the cheerleaders. Academics should always be a priority; cheerleading should be next with all other activities to follow. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. The cheerleader will maintain academic eligibility
- 2. The cheerleader will represent ORHS in a positive manner in action, dress and overall conduct, and will always exhibit acceptable standards of citizenship (e.g. in the halls, in the classroom, at events, in the community etc.)
- 3. The cheerleader will refrain from gossiping or any form of verbal or physical confrontation. This includes all electronic communication/usage (I.E. twitter, Facebook, Snapchat, Tumbler, YouTube, Instagram, etc.)
- 4. The cheerleader will enhance school spirit.
- 5. The cheerleader will wear appropriate uniforms or outfits on specific days at scheduled events.
- 6. The cheerleader will follow through with all commitments. The cheerleader will attend all games, practices and functions. They will also be on time to each one. Further, she/he will plan family outings, appointments, and other activities with the cheerleading schedule in mind first and foremost. She/he will take responsibility for reminding their parent of contacting a coach about an absence.
- 7. The cheerleader will communicate in a positive manner with teammates, coaches and staff.
- 8. The cheerleader will maintain a positive attitude toward school and cheerleading.
- 9. The cheerleader will continue to be coachable.
- 10. The cheerleader is expected to maintain and improve all skills.
- 11. The cheerleader will be able to take directions and criticism positively.
- 12. The cheerleader will be cooperative.
- 13. The cheerleader will silence his/her cell phone at practice/games.
- 14. The cheerleader will have all his/her gear with him/her at all times in the cheer bag.
- 15. The cheerleader will refrain from celebrating the misfortune or defeat of another person, team or program.
- 16. The cheerleader will accept placements and awards with dignity and class.

#### Parent Responsibilities



Cheerleading requires a significant amount of time, commitment and dedication on the part of the parents. Before tryouts, read and consider all of the information before allowing your daughter/son to try out. If your daughter/son is selected please:

- Encourage her/him to abide by the rules set forth by coaches and administrators
- Attend booster club meetings
- Pay bills on time
- Refrain from using cheerleading as a punishment. This does not punish one cheerleader, but an entire squad since there is no one to substitute for your cheerleader.
- · Agree to notify the coach if your cheerleader is ill
- Provide punctual transportation if needed (particularly if your daughter/son does not have a driver's license.)
- Direct concerns about your cheerleader on an individual basis <u>directly to the</u> coach first
- Parents/Guardians will check emails weekly and read them in their entirety for all updates. We also have a cheer Remind that distributes information. There is no excuse for being uninformed.
- Parents/Guardians expected to follow all forms of proper communication when speaking with a coach.
- Understand that coaches are responsible for practices, enforcing the rules and providing consequences and making team decisions. Coaches will not be influenced by negative comments or complaints.

Please recognize that unforeseen circumstances do occur; interim changes to anything in this document may be made at the discretion of the coaches and administration. All decisions made by the coaches and/or administration are final.

#### Cheerleader Behavioral Contract

The expectations for each member of the team is to support the balance between team supporter and the competitor. Being a member of the program, all girls/boys are expected to act appropriately and this contract is acknowledgement that you have read the following, understand and choose to obey each

responsibly. As athletes, they are now going to be the lead examples of Oak Ridge High School. Signing part of the contract. Please initial next to each statement and sign the contract below. Coaches will use this contract in addition to the established demerit system to ensure compliance. Practices are considered a mandatory event. Any practices missed will result in demerits and benching at the next scheduled event determined by the coach. 2. Games are considered mandatory. Missing a game will result in demerits and benching at the next scheduled event determined by the coach. 3. If an athlete is tardy to the game, without getting prior approval from a coach, demerits will be given. 4. In compliance with USA Cheer and Conroe ISD Recommended Cheerleading Guidelines and Procedures, no jewelry, chewing gum, fake nails/nails longer than fingertips, or hair in face during games, competitions and practices. 5. If athletes are in their uniform (except during halftime), they are to be sitting as a team in the bleachers or on the field with their team. If they wish to act as a spectator for another game or other sport, then she/he must be out of uniform and in their own clothes. \_6. Uniforms must be worn properly. This includes no bra straps showing. Only cheer shoes are acceptable to wear at cheer functions. This means that before they walk into a game, practice, pep rally or competition, cheer shoes need to be on their feet. Nothing else is acceptable. 7. While cheering at games, cheerleaders will not be allowed to socialize except at halftime. 8. Any Cheerleader who is involved in any other activities MUST give all dates, calendars, schedules, events, conflicts etc. to your coach as soon as you receive the information. Telling your coach the night before will not be acceptable. Cheerleaders will not taunt any member of an opposing team nor the referees. 10. Athletes will act respectfully to the captains and coaches at all times. Discretions or concerns will be discussed directly with the coach to find a solution to the problem. \_11. Athletes will not smoke, drink alcohol, or use any illegal substances while participating in the cheer program. Any athlete that participates in illegal activity will face immediate consequences given by the coach, which could result in immediate removal from the team. \_12. When athletes engage in text messaging or internet social networking sites, they will only use appropriate language and display appropriate pictures. Any athlete, under coaches' and administration discretion that has disrespected the name of ORHS, or the cheer program will face direct consequences, which may include removal from the team. Inappropriate language includes swearing and talking negatively about anyone. Inappropriate pictures include pictures of illegal substances, sexually explicit acts with boy/girlfriend, clothes and poses.
