1 Total Score

The sum of the student's two section scores with a range from 320-1520

The total score can help students predict how they may score on the SAT, as well as the score range they may have on the SAT, and the average score of all testers on the PSAT/NMSQT.

The percentile tells the percent of other test-takers that the student scored as well or better than among students in the same grade who tested the PSAT/NMSQT.

3 Knowledge & Skills

This section shows a graphical progress bar in each of the 8 content domains measured on the PSAT/NMSQT. This information is useful to show the student's areas of strength and areas in which to invest additional study and preparation.

The filled segments of each progress bar represents the level of mastery in that content domain, not the actual score.

Under each content domain, students can also see what percentage of the test and number of questions cover that domain. The Performance range below each filled section shows the student's score band for that domain.

2 Section Scores

The score on Reading and Writing and Math sections of the PSAT, ranging from 160-760 for each section with the percentile showing the percent of other test-takers that a student scored as well or better than among all PSAT/NMSQT test-takers.

Texas Success Initiative defines College Ready as having the following scores in each section:

- **Reading & Writing: ≥ 480**
- **Math: ≥ 530**

The score a student earns on each section is a strong indicator of the score he or she will earn on the SAT. Be sure to check your college's minimum score requirements for admission.

4 NMSC Selection Index

The National Merit Scholarship Program uses a Selection Index score based on PSAT/NMSQT scores as an initial screen of students who enter its scholarship programs. The Selection Index score is reported on a scale ranging from 48 to 228.

NMSC uses the Selection Index score to designate groups of students to receive recognition in the National Merit Scholarship Program. Entry to the 2024 NMSC competition is offered only to juniors who will graduate in 2026 for scholarships.
